Any product or piece of equipment used to maintain or improve the functional capabilities of people with disabilities is an Assistive Technology Device.

Examples include wheelchairs, vehicle modifications, hearing and vision products, computers with modifications, recreation equipment, etc.

Any service that helps an individual select, use, or purchase an assistive technology device is an Assistive Technology Service.
